
Dear parents and carers,

Launch of Behaviour Module on ClassCharts

At the end of last year we launched the app 'Class Charts' as an additional communication tool to develop our collaboration between school and home.

On Thursday 13th June, we will be activating the behaviour module of the Class Charts app. This will allow you to see the positive and negative points your child receives each day. This will automatically be added to your child's page.

You will be able to see charts which represent an overview of your child's achievement and behaviour data within a certain timeframe. By default, the displayed date range is 31 days. To view a different range of behaviour data, click on the 'Date' button to select from the available pre-sets or create your own custom date range.



Below these graphs, you can find a list of behaviour activity relating to your child. These display the behaviour that was awarded, when it was awarded, who awarded the behaviour, the lesson the behaviour was awarded in, and how many points the award is worth.

Disrupting the lesson

A reminder that 'green' behaviours represent the positives that have been awarded. Positives can be issued for a multitude of things including the main elements of our Character Code:

- Good communication
- Kindness
- Tenacity
- Showing respect
- Taking responsibility
- Excellent work

Behaviours that are 'red' symbolise negatives that have been issued.

A C1 is a warning for poor behaviour within the classroom and a C2 means that your child could no longer continue to participate in the lesson.

On the app, if a C2 was issued it will specify C2 in front of the behaviour. A C1 or C2 can be issued for:

- Not taking responsibility
- Poor communication
- Lack of kindness
- Not being respectful
- Health and safety issue

Alongside this, other negative behaviours include:

- Use of a mobile phone
- Losing a Character Card
- Incomplete Home Learning
- Unkind behaviour
- Lack of pride in work
