

Dear Parents/Carers,

4<sup>th</sup> January 2021

After the initial planning day today, we now have more information to share with you about our remote learning provision. As before, Scholars will be able to access lessons via Teams, work DOES NOT have to be completed on Teams as we have created a system whereby Scholars will be able to get the information they need either on a laptop or via a mobile phone or tablet and use pen and paper to complete the work.

We have tried to keep things as simple as possible and so have created a clear timetable for Scholars to follow with 4 hours of learning per day. Work will usually be on Teams by 9am each day, however, this may be slightly delayed tomorrow, although we expect everything to up and running by mid-day.

Each session should take an hour to complete and be assessed using a Quiz on Microsoft Teams- again this can be easily accessed through any mobile, PC, laptop, or tablet. We have included clear times for break and lunch for Scholars to help organise their day.
