Dear Parents/Carers and year 11 students

We are writing to update you with regards to this year's prom. Due to the recent announcement from the government about the delay to lifting of restrictions we are unable to host the prom as planned on July 9th. Unfortunately, the venue would not be able to host our 170 guests and we also don't feel that with the imposed restrictions the event would have the atmosphere that we want it to have.

We have however been in discussion with the venue and they have been able to rearrange the event for Friday July 23rd with all other arrangements being as they were before. This will mean that if the restrictions are lifted on July 19th then we can go ahead with the prom, despite the new date being within the school holiday. There is, of course no guarantee that restrictions will be lifted but in the event they remain we will endeavour to plan an event regardless and will communicate with you as soon as we know more information.

We hope that everyone who was planning to attend on July 9th can now attend on July 23rd but in the event you can no longer make this date please can you contact Mr Blackwood and we will arrange for a refund to be processed.
