

We would be grateful if you could return your completed forms to the school office (in the envelope provided) either by hand or in the post no later than <u>Friday 1st May</u>. Once we have received these, we can begin processing your child's application.

Transition Information

Usually at this time of year we are holding meetings with colleagues in our feeder primary schools and collecting information about each individual child. This process will still happen and Miss Briggs will be communicating with Headteachers, SENDCos and Year 6 staff in order to have a good knowledge of the children who are joining us. After the Easter holidays Miss Briggs or Mrs Howorth will be telephoning parents and carers of our new intake to provide an opportunity to introduce ourselves to you, for you to be able to ask questions and pass on any information you feel is relevant to help your child at school. We will be using the telephone numbers provided at time of application. If these numbers have changed please make sure the updated details are on the completed admission form.

In previous years we have asked Year 6 teachers to send us children's work. This process might be delayed this year and, as a substitute, we would like it if your child/ren could send a **handwritten letter** to us at school. The letter does not have to be long but could include a description of themselves, hobbies or favourite things plus the things they are looking forward to when they join the academy. These letters (with your child/ren's name) can be included in the completed forms envelope.





Induction Days

Our Induction Days are scheduled for 2nd and 3rd July. On Thursday, 2nd July we are due to hold our Year 6 Parents' Meeting. At this moment in time we do not know what government guidelines will be in place but, if these events need to be postponed, we will look to make alternative arrangements for parents and carers to meet with key staff and for the children to have their induction programme.
