### Which subjects should you choose at A level?

Choosing which subjects to study can be quite daunting so make sure you do your research and find out as much information as you can. If you are thinking about going on to higher education (i.e. university), you need to make sure that choices that you are making now will enable you to study your chosen course at university. Talk to teachers, parents and friends – be prepared to listen to their advice. When you apply to Kirk Hallam College you will have an individual meeting with a senior member of the college to discuss your course choices and how these link to future pathways. This will help to ensure that you make choices which will keep the maximum number of options open to you in the future.
