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### WELCOME

It is my pleasure to welcome you to the prospectus for the sixth form at Kirk Hallam Community Academy. We are proud to be able to offer our pupils, and those from other schools, the opportunity to study Level 3 courses in our purpose-built sixth form building, The Lakeside.

We believe that the sixth form should be an exciting period in our students' lives. Students have much more say about the curriculum they follow, and they are freed from some of the expectations of 11–16 education.

As a result, it is a time when we help them to grow as individuals and to strengthen their own core values. We help students to develop greater levels of organisation, independence and resilience, and support them through the process of planning for life after school.

Many of our students follow a combination of A-Levels that allow them to apply to university, should they wish to do so. ### **FACILITIES**

Kirk Hallam Sixth Form is based in a purpose-built facility on the main school site.

The facility includes modern learning spaces, state-ofthe-art science laboratories, a fully-equipped Design and Technology workshop including a 3D printer, computer rooms, student laptops, free Wi-Fi, a versatile performance space, private study areas and a comfortable, well-equipped student common room.

The common room incorporates a kitchen with a fridge, microwave, kettle, dishwasher, crockery and cutlery.

Our students value the calm, purposeful, business-like environment of the sixth form and the mutual respect which exists between all of those who work here.

Sixth Form students also have full use of the Kirk Hallam Sports Centre, which will give you access to the school sports hall, fitness suite, tennis courts and artificial grass pitches.





Post-16 education isn't just about academic results—we will provide you with a range of opportunities that will not only support your learning, but also develop the skills and outlook to help you later in life.

You will make new friends, learn more about your favourite subjects, visit new places and be given the opportunity to experience new things and broaden your horizons.

Through roles such as Student Ambassador, Student Mentor, Student Councillor, Anti-Bullying Ambassador and volunteering, you will develop leadership qualities and important transferable skills. You will be helped to find work experience placements and visiting speakers will introduce you to a variety of different events and activities.

You will be encouraged to set up your own interest groups and sports teams and get involved in charity fundraising events.

#### Student Council

The Student Council plays an important role in our sixth form. Elected by their peers, Student Council members provide the student body with an organised voice. The council meets regularly to address issues, organise social events and feedback concerns to the Head or Deputy Head of Sixth Form.

In the past, the council has worked closely with the Catering Manager to improve the lunchtime food provision, been instrumental in the re-introduction of a drinks vending machine and modified the sixth form dress code.



We encourage prospective students to do lots of research on the subjects they are thinking of choosing to avoid any surprises once their courses start.

Your choice of subjects should reflect your interests, your academic abilities, and any plans you have for your future career.

To help you make the right subject choices, you can request an interview with an admissions adviser at the application stage and also once you have received your GCSE results.

### HOW TO APPLY

We welcome applications from students currently at Kirk Hallam Community Academy, as well as those from elsewhere. It is one of the strengths of our sixth form that we have a vibrant mix of students from different schools.

We encourage you to attend our annual open evening where you can see for yourself what we have to offer and discuss courses with the teachers who deliver them. This will also give you the opportunity to meet some of our current students and find out from them what their experience has been.

#### **Entry requirements**

To join the Kirk Hallam Sixth Form, you need to have at least five GCSEs at grade 5 or above, or equivalent Level 2 qualifications. We prefer students to have at least a grade 6 at GCSE in the subjects they choose at A-Level, but this is only an absolute requirement for Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Maths, German and French.

Students with a grade 3 in either GCSE Maths or GCSE English Language, but who satisfy the other entry requirements, should not be discouraged from applying as we offer the opportunity for resits in these two subjects.





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
